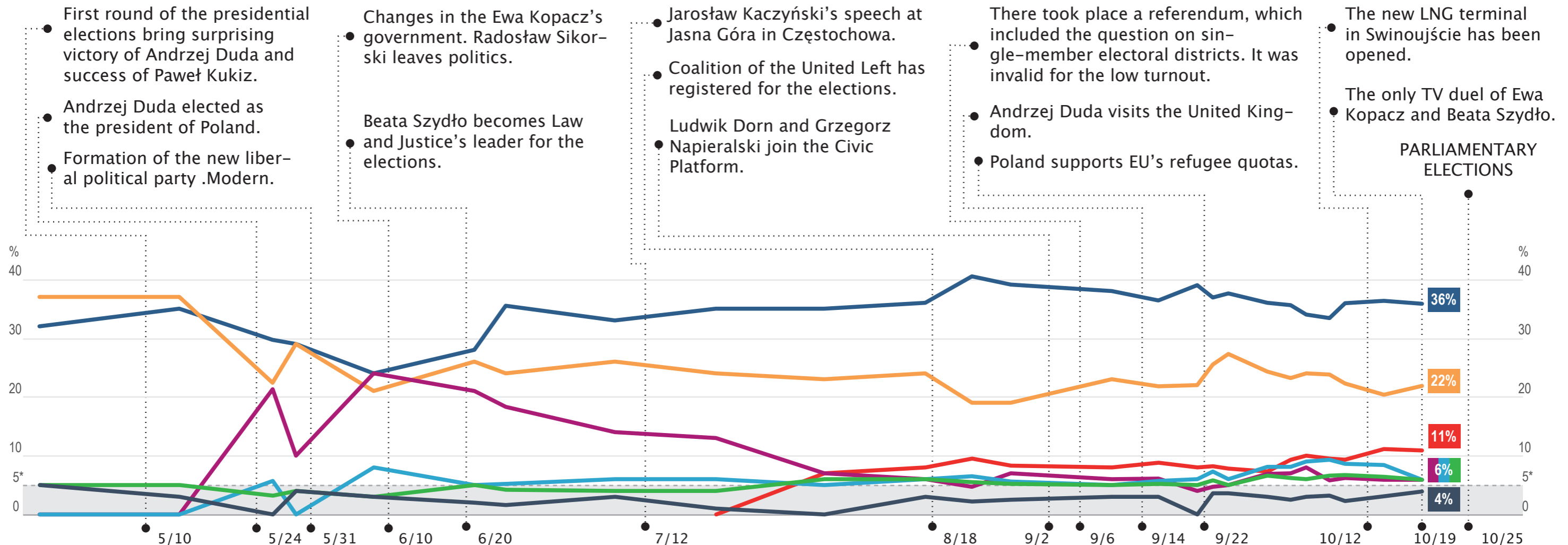


MAIN CAMPAIGN EVENTS | DEVELOPMENT OF THE OPINION POLLS

Law and Justice + Kukiz15

+ Kukiz would be the easiest partner for PiS as far as policy programme concessions are concerned. He also mentioned that he could support the government lead by PiS.

- Kukiz is also an illegible politician and PiS has painful experience with the government depending on little non-experienced parties from years 2005-2007.

+ "The Hungarian scenario". Same as to Victor Orbán in Hungary, the result would allow PiS to commence fundamental changes in the country.

+ The bloc of "anti-PiS" parties. Yet, the rejection of the Law and Justice may become the only issue the parties agree on.

- Such a broad coalition would hardly find an agreement on the economic programme. Moreover, the coalition would have to cope with presidential vetoes.
