

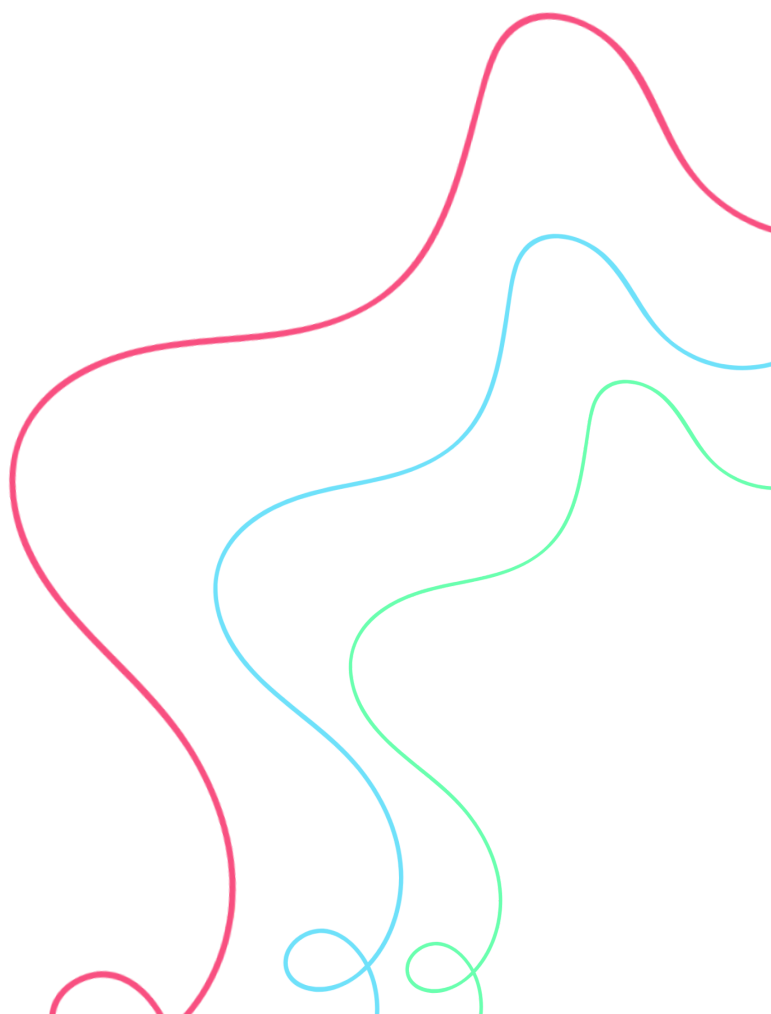

Dear partners, colleagues,

We are pleased to share with you information about our activities in 2024. Our work as a non-governmental, non-profit organization is only possible thanks to the trust placed in us by the public and our supporters.

We were delighted to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the Prague Student Summit. This key educational project continues to enjoy enormous interest among young people. It offers them a unique insight into the world of international politics and strengthens their civic competencies. This was not our only celebration, as the Czech-German Program for Young Professionals commemorated its 15th anniversary. During its existence, the program has connected many remarkable talents from various fields.

Our intensive work in Ukraine continued, where our main goal remains to support Ukrainian education in the context of the war. We were also actively involved in discussions on the post-war reconstruction of the country. In 2024, we expanded our activities to Serbia. We shared the Czech experience of investigating foreign influence with local independent media.

In the area of our long-term expert activities focused on China's penetration into Central and Eastern Europe, we achieved significant recognition in 2024 when we were given the opportunity to present the results of our work in the US Congress. At the same time, we decided to actively contribute to reducing the Czech Republic's remaining dependencies on Russia and intensively sought concrete ways to achieve this. We also organized the first international conference dedicated to material dependencies and their impact on the geopolitics of the green transition.

Our efforts to provide the public with the best possible information on European and global issues included not only more than 750 media appearances by members of our team, but also dozens of debates organized with local libraries and other institutions throughout the Czech Republic.

We continue to strive to ensure that women's voices are heard in international politics, and we have therefore continued to develop our database of female experts and our network of women in Czech foreign policy.



We thank you for your favor and support, without which our work would not be possible. We accept all our achievements with humbleness, as a commitment and motivation to fulfill our mission and vision.

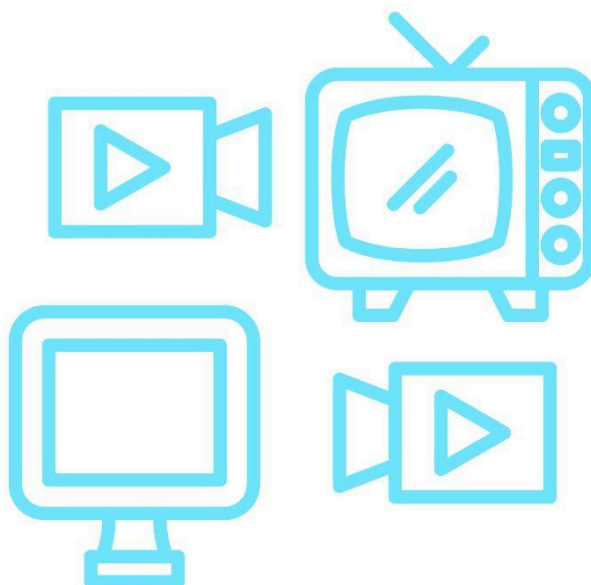

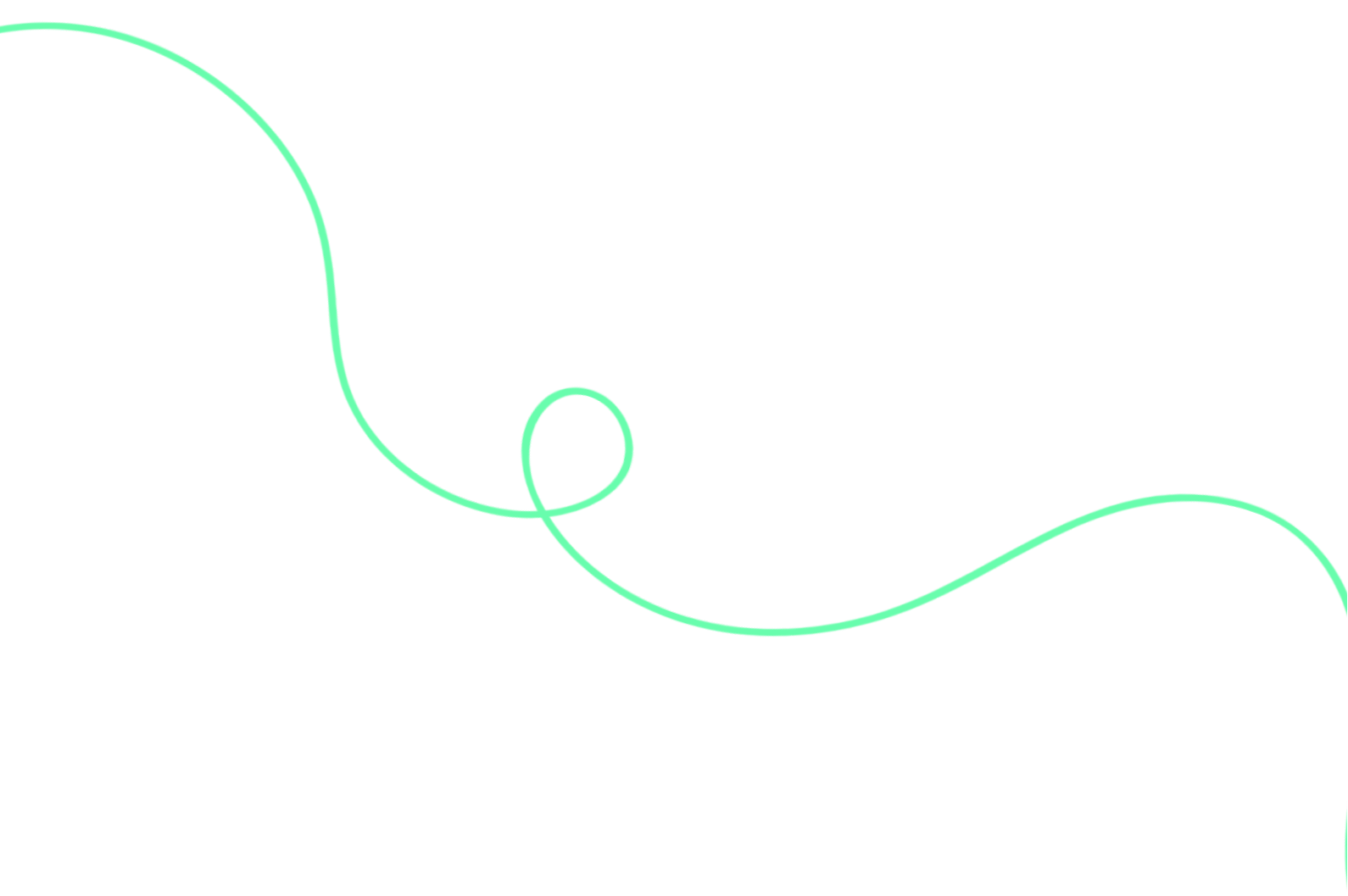
