

Dear partners, colleagues,

You have received the AMO 2023 Annual Report. In the past year, we have been engaged in an intensive internal discussion about our mission and vision. At the September membership meeting, we reaffirmed our core values and direction and you will find them in this annual report.

In 2023, we continued to focus on Russian aggression against Ukraine. Even during the war, we continue our development and transition projects on the ground and reflect on the reconstruction of the country. We analyze the impact of the war on the international community and address the new challenges it poses for the European Union, climate and energy. We track China's behavior in today's increasingly multipolar world. As the European Parliament elections approached, we increasingly focused on the Czech debate on Europe and the risks of foreign interference in these elections.

At AMO we want to explain international issues to as wide a public as possible. In addition to yet another record media coverage, last year we visited a number of places in the Czech Republic to talk to the public about international politics, thanks to increased cooperation with local libraries.

We remain committed to ensuring that international politics is not just about men. We are developing a database of women experts in international politics and a network of women who work professionally in international relations.

The Prague Student Summit has launched an alumni club as it approaches its 30th anniversary. Thousands of young people have passed through this project during its existence. We believe that this experience has contributed to making them more knowledgeable about international issues. We want to be in closer contact with them and to be their qualified guides in an increasingly uncertain world.

A huge thank you to all those who have contributed to our work over the past year. We are pleased that our activities are perceived as beneficial by the public as well as by the professional community in the Czech Republic and abroad. An example of this is the Climate Change Communication Award we received last year.



We accept all our achievements last year with humility and as a commitment to further improve our activities. Thank you for your support, without which our work would not be possible.


